Running Order:

The dog running order will be posted at the score table and in the blind for each trial. All requests for running order changes must be approved by the Trial Secretary. Class running order is subject to change based on actual entries at time of closing. Estimated start times will be provided for trials expected to run longer than four hours. The preliminary run order is as follows:

Single ring format:

- Saturday: Instinct, Novice, Novice, Open, Open, Crazy 8s, Senior, Master, Crazy 8s, Senior, Master
- Sunday: Master, Senior, Crazy 8s, Master, Senior, Crazy 8s, Open, Open, Instinct, Novice, Novice

Start Times:

Trial begins at 8:30 AM Saturday and Sunday. Estimated start times will be used for this trial.

Notice of Filming:

When participating in the Revolution Dog Sports, LLC event, you enter an area where photography, audio, and video recording may occur. By entering the event site, you consent to photography, audio recording, video recording and its/their release, publication, exhibition, or reproduction to be used for news, web casts, promotional purposes, telecasts, advertising, training, documentation, inclusion on websites, social media, or any other purpose by Revolution Dog Sports, LLC and its affiliates and representatives. The video release is included in the terms and conditions of online entries through revolutiondogsports.com. Exhibitors mailing in entries will be required to sign a waiver before participating in the event. Video may be available for purchase.

Awards:

Awards are self –service at the awards table. Exhibitors must be present for awards. Awards will not be mailed or available for pick up at a later date except for RATCHX and above ribbons.

All Classes:

Qualifying Score: Brown Flat Ribbon

Rosettes are offered for new titleholders in Novice and above.

Exhibitors earning a RATCHX or higher title may choose a customized ribbon to be ordered by Revolution Dog Sports, LLC or a standard RATCHX ribbon.

Novice and Above:

- Ribbons are offered for First through Fourth place in each height division.
- High in Class will be awarded in classes where there are two or more qualifying runs.
- High combined will be awarded once each day for the fastest time of the two trials in a class where there are two or more qualifying runs.
- Master of Masters: Offered to the dog and handler team with the highest number of qualifying scores in Masters. In the event of a tie, the fastest time wins.
- Point Crazy: Offered to the dog and handler team who earn the most cumulative points in Crazy 8s throughout the weekend.
- Speed Racer: Offered to the dog and handler team with the fastest time in Novice, Open, Senior and Master classes.

Venue:

Please plan for all crating conditions. Revolution Dog Sports reserves the right to remove any individual for any reason from the premises. No refunds will be issued. Dogs are not permitted outside of the trial grounds. Flexi leads and leads longer than 6' are not permitted on the trial grounds.

Notice to Exhibitors:

• This event is open to all dogs 6 months of age and older.

- Withdrawal of entry before the closing date will receive a refund mailed within 7 days of the closing date. All other refunds will be mailed 7 days after the event.
- No refund or credit will be made for cancellations after the closing date.
- No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A declined payment or returned check does
 not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$40 fee for any returned check or payment. Checks must be
 made payable to Revolution Dog Sports. There is no fee for payment by PayPal. Entries where payment
 has not been received within 3 days of receipt of entry will be cancelled.

Eligibility:

Dogs may enter both Instinct and Novice in the same trial until the dog has earned the RATN title. A dog that has earned an RATN may no longer enter the Instinct Test. Exception: If the dog is already entered in Instinct at the trial and earns its Novice title, it may continue to compete in Instinct for that weekend only.

Dogs must be eligible to run a class at the time of entry. Dogs who complete a title at a trial may move up, at the discretion of the handler, in the next trial. Please make move-up requests at the score table before the lunch break or before leaving the afternoon trial. Handlers are responsible for making the request in time for the move-up to be processed.
