• Instinct 1 / 2, Novice 1 /2, Master 1 , Open 1, Senior 1, Open 2, Senior 2, Master 2

Notice to Exhibitors:

- This event is open to all dogs 6 months of age and older.
- Withdrawal of entry fee before the closing date will receive a refund. Refunds will be made within seven 7 after the event.
- No refunds will be made for cancellations made after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms and class change forms.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for behavior of their dogs, children and / or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and / guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at al time except when in the ring.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or ay cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A declined payment or returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$40 fee for any returned check or payment. Checks must be made payable to Revolution Dog Sports. There is no fee for payment by PayPal.

Classes offered each day:

Dogs may enter both Instinct and Novice in the same trial until the dog has earned the RATN title. A dog that has earned a RATN may no longer enter the Instinct Test. Exception: If the dog is already entered in Instinct at the trial and earns its Novice title, it may continue to compete in Instinct for that weekend.

When offered, dogs may enter one regular class and Crazy 8s in each trial. Dogs must be eligible to run a class at the time of entry. Dogs who complete a title at a trial may move up, at the discretion of the handler, in the next trial when the run order permits. Please make move-up requests at the score table before the lunch break or before leaving the afternoon trial. Handlers are responsible for making the request in time for the move up to be processed.

Move Ups, Move Downs and Lateral Moves:

Move ups, move downs and lateral moves are permitted. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know their dog's eligibility. Class changes must be made prior to the start of each class.
