### WAIT LIST INFORMATION

**Sierra Nevada Scent Work Club** is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **10 entries per day** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **09/02/2018**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on 09/02/2018. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

### EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

**Trial Site.** It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date.

**Crating space** will not be available.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

**Dogs should be physically sound.** Dogs that are lame, blind, deaf or have open sores shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is bandaged, stitched or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes. If course conditions warrant, protective footwear may be worn if approved by the judge.

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle collars, snap collars or slip collars but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Pinch collars, electronic collars and dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area.

Farm Dog Certification and AKC Herding regulations are available from the American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Drive, Suite 200, Raleigh, NV 27606-3390. Exhibitors are expected to be familiar with the rules and regulations.

### REFUNDS

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are eligible for a 50% refund with a veterinarian note.

**Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

### RINGSIDE

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

I-80 East or West: Exit US 395 North toward Susanville. Take Exit 74 for Lemmon Drive. Turn right onto Lemmon Drive. Turn right onto Waterash Street. Turn right onto Tupelo Street. Turn left onto Matterhorn Boulevard. Turn right onto Antelope Valley Road. The driveway will be on the left.



AGREEMENT

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
